In January 2020 we held the first doctoral conference on public education and pedagogy at the entre for Public Education and Pedagogy, Maynooth University, Ireland. This is an event where doctoral students can present their ongoing work on questions concerning public education and (public) pedagogy. We will issue a full announcement early in December 2020.
